INNOVATIVE DESIGN

Be-Poles was born at the beginning of the 2000's and developed in Paris and New York with the aim of : building strong and long-lasting brands, based on strong basis and not on passing fads. We often introduce ourselves as a designs studio rather than as an agency. Creation, guided by our intuition, is at the core of our approach.

We always wanted to think about the brand not as a logo but as stories to live and memories to create. Our job consists of understanding and telling a brand's story with sensitivity, intelligence and experience to allow it to be understood. To conclude, our narrative approach will serve their brand's speech.

Meeting ZAG was the perfect opportunity to combine this approach with the brands and our enthusiasm for mountains. 

ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY

Our two engineers Bastien Saillard and Nicolas Perier design our skis in the ZAG Lab located in Chamonix with the goal of satisfying the many tastes of our customers. Always hungry to improve, they spend their time studying innovative shapes, materials, and constructions.

"We are compelled to endlessly innovate by creating skis that are increasingly intuitive, comfortable, high performing, and that provide skiers with a unique riding experience."

The ZAG LAB allows our engineers to create prototypes in record time, and its prime location in Chamonix lets us test them right away and make improvements accordingly. To create our all-mountain range (H PATROL), for example, the team was able to test the skis on all types of snow in order to develop a new and versatile range dedicated to resort skiing.




LIGHT

The combination to procure lightness and comfort, while having a rigid construction at the same time in torsion and flexion, with exemplary reliability. The perfect mechanical characteristics for ski touring! This construction is therefore for the touring line. High modulus and high resistance carbon fibers give the skis the lightness and rigidity expected by the demanding hikers. Kevlar fibers absorb vibrations to give an impeccable touch of snow, on the hard or in the powder.



LIGHT . UBAC

One goal: to allow skiers to have a light and comfortable ski in all types of snow. This result is achieved through the combination of glass and carbon fibers, making the Touring UBAC skis twice as stiff in torsion. The paulownia wood core allows you to fetch a few extra grams, without affecting the touch of snow and the resistance of the material. ABS sidewalls and high resistance steel edges help the ski to resist the impacts therefore to ski safely!


HEAVY DUTY. H

The best compromise between stiffness in flexion and torsion. Composed of a double layer multiaxial fiberglass, the objective is to make skis effective in all types of snow. From the legendary H-112, having proven these to the feet of our best riders, the Heavy Duty construction gives skiers reliability and maximum safety. Lightweight, for more off-road flotation, but rigid, to fully enjoy days of trafolle, this construction makes the ski catchy on hard snow so to link the curves!





Lightness and power to hit the slopes and the large fields of fresh snow. This construction uses multi-axial fiberglass, increasing the skiability and power by providing stiffness in torsion and flexion. The goal is also to reduce the final weight of these XXL skis, hence the presence of paulownia for lightness, in addition to the poplar for resistance. In the end, this construction makes skis light, playful, stable at high speed and resistant in time that characterize the legendary SLAP's DNA.





EDGES

The edges on all skis come from 100% recycled steel. Presenting the best hardness/ strength compromise, these edges are highly shock resistant while avoiding breakage, especially off-piste.



SIDEWALLS

The ABS sidewalls are present on the H, SLAP et UBAC ranges. They allow the skis to have increased durability and, because of their rigidity, a better transmission of the power on the edges.



TOPSHEET

In order to make the skis more resistant to repeated outings, ZAG skis are equipped with polyamide topsheet. This transparent and material allows to highlight the colors of the skis, while guaranteeing the highest impact and scratch resistance on the market.



REINFORCING PLATES

In order to guarantee optimal fastening performance, ZAG integrates, in the design of all its models, phenol reinforcements in which the bindings are anchored.



BASE

The sintered base, high molecular weight, present on all the models, have the advantage of being stronger and more resistant to shocks and abrasion than extruded base. This base also has better wax absorption capacity and provides better glide.



WOOD CORE

Essential part of the skis, providing both the soul and the skiability, the cores present in the skis are composed of different species of wood, poplar and paulownia, according to the desired characteristics for the skis.



STABILITY LINK - LINEN FIBER

Inserting flax fibres allows a maximum vibration absorption.



CAMBER

ZAG cambers' are adapted and calibrated according to each range to obtain the right behavior. It influences stability, grip and energy transfer.

ROCKER

ZAG rockers' are long and progressive which allows an excellent lift off and a very good handling on all types of snow.



5 POINTS SHAPE

Specific shape technic that enables us to increase the handling and playability of the skis.



MULTI-RADIUS SHAPE

Drawing method that allows to vary the radius in several independent areas all along the ski. For instance, it allows to have a very short radius under the feet but greatly enlarged at the ends to improve tolerance in difficult snow.



TORSION

To get an ideal ratio adhesion/comfort, ZAG skis have a resistance to torsion value that evolves according to the widths and programs of the skis.



FLEX

ZAG skis are developed with the most progressive flex curves, always providing soften tip and rebound tail.



RESIN

The resin used in all ZAG models has been rigorously selected for its excellent bonding and mechanical strength properties. As far as possible, ZAG strives to use bio-sourced resins with minimum carbon impact.



In cooperation with its suppliers, ZAG has developed quality weaves adapted to the different constructions in its different ranges. This tailor-made weaving of glass, carbon and or Kevlar fibers, make possible the optimization of weight, strenght and ability of skis.



PROGRAM

Aware that our playground is threatened and that the quality of the air in the valley is more and more an issue of discussion, ZAG has launched the ZAGreen Program. Created in 2017, the aim of this program is to reduce the environmental impact of the ski industry. The actions that will be done will concern the manufacturing of the products, the way we practice skiing and also the daily life in our office. In addition to the measures involving only the company, the aim is to increase awareness among the whole community about the environmental challenge that is the air quality in our valley. ZAGreen is a project that hopes to be heard and also to involve more actors of this beautiful place.

This program's emblem is the snowy owl. This huge white bird conveys the idea of pure natural areas that are the playground of the brand. ZAG associates its brand to this rare and protected bird to achieve its ecofriendly project.

The enrolment of the ski-touring line in the project 1% for the planet also helps ZAG reaching its goal : preserving its playground. In 2019, ZAG had redistributed that percentage to the association Mountain Wilderness.



BIO SOURCED RESIN

We have used a resin which is 33% biosourced to produce the models ADRETS since 2016. It is mainly composed of oil produced with oil plants.
